

# 3D Summer Archery League, Summer 2023

## Registration

- Please bring your \$25 registration fee on first night of league

## Dates & Cost

- Summer 2023 dates: July 19 to September 6, every Wednesday at 6pm
- Cost: \$25 registration fee + \$5 weekly fee

## Rules

- We will shoot at 15 targets (marked with orange flags) in a group format.
- Each participant shoots two arrows per target.
- Shooting stake distances are as follows:

Blue	50 yards	Yellow	35 yards
Green	45 yards	Orange	30 yards
Red	40 yards	White	25 yards
- No Crossbows, No Broadheads, No Range finders
- Participants must play in 6 of 8 league scheduled shoots to qualify for 50/50
- League shooters not members of the LVFGC range may park outside the gate and walk in

## Scoring

- **Targets and Arrows:** We will use 15 Rinehart 3D targets and shoot 2 arrows on each target
- **Scoring:** Center vital ring 10, Outer vital ring 8, Body shots 5, Leg shots 0  
(The X ring is optional depending on what we decide; it can be scored as 30 points or simply marked as an X for breaking ties)
- **Scratch:** Maximum Score is 300pts (330 pts possible if using X ring)
- **Handicaps:** Members will have their handicap calculated when 2 rounds have been completed. Handicap calculation will be as follows:
  - **Handicap calculation:**  $(300 - \text{Average Score}) \times 0.85$
  - **Average Score** is based on the average of your previous two scores entered (Weeks 1 and 2 handicap will be based on scores from those two weeks)
  - **Weekly handicapped score:** Weekly scratch score + handicap
  - **Maximum handicapped score is 300 (330 for X ring scoring)** Example: A scratch score of 270 + a handicap of 35 will result in a handicapped score of 300 not counting the X ring, 330 if the X ring is counted.
- **Scorecards** will be provided and filled out by individual participants. Participants will record their own score on a master scoresheet before leaving each week. League organizer will tally the final master scoresheet. Participants are encouraged to retain all their scorecards.
- **50/50 Winner** will be based on the individual's highest total average handicapped score
- **Award Ceremony** will be held during the End of League Celebration on September 23, 2023
